- 1) Always use uplifting, polite and considerate language. Avoid bad language.
- 2) Be courteous to our hosts, leaders and chaperones. Show respect for personal space; and public, church and personal property. This applies especially to the buses and the Seneca Lake campsite.
- 3) Avoid inappropriate conduct, including loud or destructive behavior and pranks.
- 4) Obey the Lord's rules for moral conduct, the Word of Wisdom and the Golden Rule.
- 5) Stay out of the opposite sex rooms.
- 6) Personal music devices with earphones playing appropriate music or personal video games with appropriate games are permitted during bus travel to and from Palmyra. In order to fully experience the spirit of the occasion, these electronic items should not be used once we arrive Saturday afternoon until we depart on Monday, except to communicate with parents, to access scriptures, and to take pictures. Optional: you may want to give your device to the designated adult leader who will store it in a safe location until departure time on Monday.
- 7) Obey curfews, lights out and other rules established by the Stake leaders.
- 8) Abide by the dress standards for the various activities as described in the "What to Bring' Section of the DC Stake Youth website.
- 9) Use common sense, listen to your conscience and follow the Spirit at all times.
- 10) Willingly participate in all scheduled activities of the conference. Stay with your group during the conference.
- 11) Leave a good impression of our Stake wherever you go by being polite, respectful, keeping things clean and orderly, and by remembering who you are at all times.
- 12) Follow the Gospel of Jesus Christ. Think what He would do in your situation.
